| Clinical Procedure | (Step 1: Clean) Prime pump for first use. Wet hands then dispense a small amount of Handicare Handwash into the palm of a hand. Rub hands together to form a lather, working the lather all over the hands, base of arms and inbetween fingers and finger nails (scrubbing brush will help clean finger nails). Rinse thoroughly, still rubbing lathered areas, until lather is visibly removed. Follow your infection control procedures to prepare for next procedure. |
