PROPER USE OF SURGICAL (TIE) MASKS

DONNING A MASK



Wash your hands



Hold the top of the mask: grasping the middle of the nose piece

 Please ensure the color side is facing out and the pleats fold downward



Pull on the bottom of the mask to open up the pleats to form a breathing chamber



Place on the bridge of your nose, and press the metal nose piece to fit around your nose and cheeks



Fasten the ties to ensure a secure fit - the top tie should sit at the crown of your head



The bottom tie should go behind your neck

DOFFING THE MASK

Undo the ties



Touch only the ties or the edges of the mask



Discard into waste bin

IMPORTANT POINTS

- The mask should completely cover the nose, mouth and chin
- Masks are for single use, do not use for more than one patient or procedure
- Do not save in your pocket for re-use, or dangle from your neck
- A well-secured nose piece will prevent fogging of your glasses
- To adjust a visor mask, slide two fingers up from below the visor and push down on the nose piece



PROPER USE OF PROCEDURE (EAR LOOP) MASKS

DONNING A MASK



Wash your hands



Hold the top of the mask: grasping the middle of the nose piece

Place on the bridge of your nose, and press the metal nose piece to fit around your nose and cheeks



Wrap the ear loops behind each ear

DOFFING THE MASK



Pull off by the ear loops



Touch only the ear loops or the edges of the mask



Discard into waste bin
